St. Brandon (or Brendan) was one of the disciples of St. Finnian of Clonard, known collectively as the Twelve Apostles on Ireland. Born in Tralee, St. Brandon was educated by SS. Ita and Erc, and then ordained by St. Jarlath of Tuam in 512. Called “the Navigator”, he voyaged to the Hebrides (and according to some legends, much farther) founding monasteries and leading missions to convert the Picts.

Another of the Twelve Apostles of Ireland, St. Columba was born in what is now Ulster, at a time when Christian education was doing much to convert the Gaelic world. After his monastic formation, he voyaged to the west coast of Scotland, founding a monastery on the isle of Iona which became a centre for missions to the Northern Pictish Kingdoms. Many miracles are attributed to him, as are the Rule of St. Columba and the hymns, *Adiutor Laborantium* and *Altus Prosator*, both still sung today.
